The most popular cruise for wildlife viewing on the Peninsula. Seabirds, bald eagles, harbor seals, harbor porpoises, elephant seals and more can be seen. Approximately 70 percent of the nesting seabirds from this area breed and nest on the island. It also claims one of the largest nesting colonies of rhinoceros auklets in the world and the largest nesting colony of 'glaucous-winged' gulls in Washington. The island contains one of the last 2 nesting colonies of tufted puffins in the Puget Sound area. About 1,000 harbor seals depend upon the island for a 'pupping' and rest area.
